

Tamborine Mountain Bridge Club

Rules and Regulations

MOBILE PHONES	Mobile phones are not to be used in playing areas. They must be turned off or on silent.
ETIQUETTE	Courtesy at the Bridge table means doing nothing to cause discomfort to others.
SMOKING	No smoking anywhere inside the building or within 2 metres of an open window.
PERFUME	Perfume can result in an allergic reaction for some members, in view of this it is requested perfume not be worn.
SEATING	Players should be seated 15 minutes prior to play
DRESS	Players should observe a reasonable standard of dress (smart casual) No singlets, football shorts, thongs or bare feet.
CONTACT DETAILS	Change of contact details should be advised to the Secretary ASAP
COMPLAINTS	Any complaint should be forwarded to the Secretary in writing – verbal or Unsigned complaints will not be addressed.
REGULATION	QBA regulations will apply at all times.
SYSTEMS	Only Green or Blue Systems are allowed at club sessions.
SYSTEM CARDS	A fully completed current system card is required for each pair at Club sessions. For congress and major competitions, 2 System Cards per pair are required.
BOARD MOVEMENT	North/South to be responsible for placing and moving boards.
CARDS	Must be counted before play.
OPENING LEAD	The opening lead is to be made face down.
SCORING	North/South is responsible for scoring & East/West is responsible for checking each score and OK-ing.
TALKING	Talking at table during play should be quiet and kept to a minimum. No discussion should occur about hand just played.
DIRECTOR	The Director must be called for any Infraction of the laws including rudeness & unethical behaviour.
SCORING ERRORS	Should be reported to the Director during play.
SLOW PLAY	Each pair may have only one average board per session for slow play. Other late boards shall be allocated an Average Minus, with an Average Plus to the opposition.
DEFIBRILLATOR	The Club has a Defibrillator and will show Video of Instructions periodically, to ensure members are able to use in the case of an emergency.
AFTER PLAY	To spread the work load it is appreciated that players assist with: Cups/glasses to be placed in dishwasher after use – kitchen to be left clean and tidy – waste baskets to be emptied into appropriate bins – boards to be replaced – windows closed and locked - Bridgemates to be returned to the box.
DEALING	Teams of two/ three are required to deal with boxes of boards as per roster.
