Bridge Opening Leads

Statistically, the opening lead is far and away the most important single card the defence plays. Half the time you are defending.

This is a Guide only it depends on the shape of your hand & information available.

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Opening Leads against a Notrump Contract

The defence gets a vital opportunity to establish their suit, act wisely! Generally lead your longest and strongest suit.
