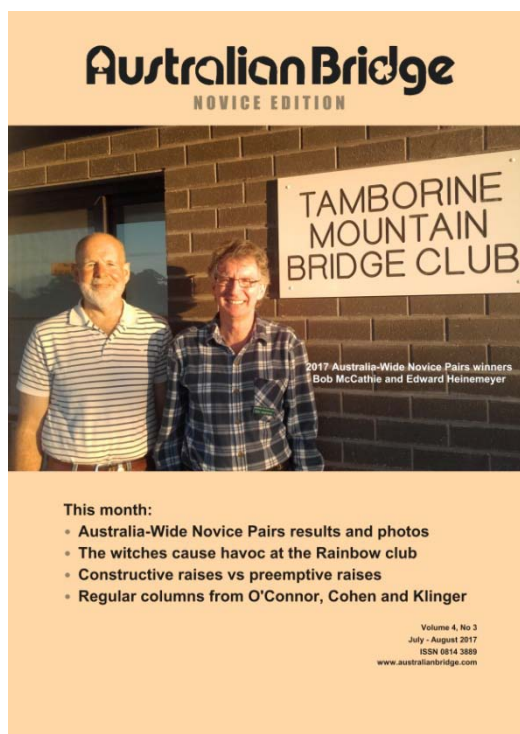




Locals win national bridge competition
