Table Etiquette.

I have noticed that several players (inc. Me) do not observe the Law 74 enough. I can understand the newer players not being fully aware but it annoys me when seasoned players DO NOT.

## **LAW 74 - CONDUCT AND ETIQUETTE**

Proper Attitude 1. A player should maintain a courteous attitude at all times. 2. A player should carefully avoid any remark or extraneous action that might cause annoyance or embarrassment to another player or might interfere with the enjoyment of the game. 3. Every player should follow uniform and correct procedure in calling and playing.

Classic examples are when your partners bid does not mean what it says. i.e 1C could be 1,2 or natural. Please state at the time.

We should also welcome the opposition to the table (sometimes does get forgotten.
